Nez Perce Tribe Solid Waste Drop Location Guidelines



For resident owners within and around the Lapwai Valley



This is a temporary solid waste drop location provided to resident owners only as an option to those homes that do not have curbside. Residents are required to register at the Tribe's Water Resources Division to set up an account. No money will be accepted at the drop location but registration forms will be handed out with this guideline brochure and a receipt for record. Waste will not be accepted until an account is set up. Tribal Police will be on standby to assist in any disputes. A video of operations is standard for ensuring monitoring.

1. Begin with the check point
2. Registration and waste assessment need to be confirmed, the monitor will direct where to dump
3. All household waste needs to be in sealed bags
4. Residents dump their own waste, can buy a bag, \$1

\$18 per resident residing in the Lapwai Valley
\$20 per resident residing outside the Lapwai Valley
 Lapwai Valley include areas from Webb Road to Spaulding along Hwy 95, Tom Beal, Garden Gulch, Soldiers Canyon, Beaver Grade, and Mann Lake area.

Outside the Lapwai Valley include: All areas not mentioned are outside of the Lapwai Valley area.

Recycling is offered at the drop location.

Here are some items that are accepted:



= Bottles only, no caps



= Aluminum cans



= Cardboard, flattened



= Bulky metal accepted: appliances, motor parts, exercise equipment, bed frames, any metal, etc.
