Aluminum cans - empty &
rinsed*
Office paper, envelopes,
catalogs
& magazines
Shredded paper - in clear
plastic bags
Newspaper
Used printer/ink cartridges
Used candles
Cardboard - flattened
Tin cans - empty & rinsed*
Car batteries

*If it is not rinsed it is considered contaminated and goes straight to the landfill - the opposite of what we're trying to do!
